## Services

Clinton Police Department offers numerous services to the public in order to enhance the lives of the citizens of Clinton, North Carolina.

Under the leadership of Chief Edwards the police officers of Clinton Police Department are dedicated to providing quality service with Integrity, Professionalism, Respect, and Teamwork with the community. Many of the services provided are free.

A few of the services that are offered include: Home security survey, Property registration, Medicine Drop, Home and Business Checks, Trespassing agreements, Fingerprinting, Public Speaking Events, K-9 Demonstrations, etc.



### Home Security Survey

Home security survey consists of a survey of your home conducted by a Clinton Police Officer. The officer will advise on landscaping, lighting, home repairs, etc. to create a safe and secure community. If you have questions or wish to have a survey completed contact the Operations Commander.



### Register Your Property

Clinton City residents may bring their personal property to the Clinton Police Department to be registered. The serial number, description, and photo of the property are entered into the agency's record management system. Please Call and speak with an Administrative Records Specialist for more information.

*If you are unable to bring your property to the department, contact the Services Commander to schedule a time an officer may meet with you.*

### Residence Checks

Residence checks can be conducted by request. Make contact with an Administrative Records Specialist Monday-Friday 8AM-5PM, at 910-592-3105 to complete a Residence Check request form.

### Traffic Safety Survey

The department uses traffic monitoring equipment and officer observations to identify traffic volume and/or safety concerns. If you have a traffic issue and wish to have an area assessed, contact the Operations Commander to discuss available options.

### Medicine Drop



Bring your potentially dangerous, expired, unused, and unwanted prescriptions to Clinton Police Department for safe and free disposal.

### Fingerprinting

Fingerprinting is offered on Tuesday and Thursday 8AM-5PM at a cost of \$10.00 per person. Call to schedule an appointment.

Juvenile Fingerprinting Kits can also be obtained at the police department. Contact an Administrative Records Specialist.

### Trespassing Agreements

Protect your home or business from trespassers. Sign a trespassing agreement with Clinton Police Department by contacting the Operations Commander at 910-592-3105.

### Code Enforcement

Clinton Police Department enforces violations of nuisance vehicles in accordance with Clinton City Code Ordinances, which can be located on the City of Clinton website [www.cityofclintonnc.com](http://www.cityofclintonnc.com). Contact the Services Commander if you have questions or wish to report a violation.

ABC permits are issued by the Chief of Police. Inspections and investigations are conducted by the Services Division in partnership with NC ALE. Contact the Services Commander with any questions or concerns.
