NOTICE: Pursuit to The City of Clinton Code of Ordinances , Chapter 14 Licenses and Registration Article V. Itinerant Merchant/Peddler Registration It shall be unlawful for a transient merchant, itinerant merchant, itinerant vendor or a peddler to engage in such business within the city without first registering with the Clinton Police Department. A separate permit is required of each individual conducting such sales.

Applications must be submitted to the Clinton Police Department at least ten (10) days in advance of the planned use.


